Ichinoseki Kids Science



On November 18, the hands-on science experience 'Ichinoseki Kids Science' was held at Kawasaki Civic Center.

42 elementary students from the city participated. With the Engineering Girls of Iwate University as instructors, the students made snowdomes derived from the city's recycled gold and watched experiments using carbon dioxide and enjoyed colorful flame reactions.

The students also learned the importance of environmental protection through the process of recovering gold leaf from computer parts and by watching what happens when carbon dioxide dissolves in water.

ILC Lecture

The Construction Area Association for the Realization of the ILC held a lecture on the International Linear Collider (ILC) at the Bellino Hotel Ichinoseki, on December 6.

170 people attended the speech, including association members. The speakers were Atsushi Sunami, president of the Sasakawa Peace Foundation, and Shinichiro Michizono, a professor at the High Energy Accelerator Research Organization (KEK).



The event created momentum for the International Linear Collider Project's realization through lectures on the project's significance from the standpoints of science and technology diplomacy and economic security, as well as the current state of accelerator technology development.
